



KINDI KIDS LOVE TO DRAW

Give each child a piece of paper and a pencil or crayon. Have them all write their names in the top corner then swap papers with someone else in the room. For the first round, give them one minute to draw the outline of their partner's head, then switch the papers again with someone else in the room.

Each round they must draw a different part of the face—hair, eyes, nose, mouth and ears—switching papers with a new person between each round. Once completed, return the paper to its original owner.
